FEATURES

FACE IDENTIFICATION can be separated into three distinct categories: known, unknown and alert.

EMAIL NOTIFICATION displays camera location, name, notes and photos of the alert. **MONITOR ALERTS** allow for playback video feature and detailed person information with a single click.
